WHAT DOES CLEARSTEAD TRUST, LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

What Information is Collected?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. We may collect information directly and indirectly from you, such as information you provide to us, information shared with us from third parties, and information collected relating to your device, browser and preferences. This information can include:

Personal Information, such as:

- Name
- Postal Address
- Email Address
- Social Security number/Tax-Identification Number

Financial Information, such as:

- Income
- Assets
- Account balances

Device Information, such as:

- Cookies
- Log Files
- IP Addresses

What are your rights?

Under certain circumstances, you may have rights in relation to your personal data, which may include the right to:

- Request access to your personal data;
- Request correction to your personal data;
- Request erasure of your personal data;
- Object to processing of your personal data;
- Request restriction of processing your personal data;
- Object to automated decision-making;
- Request transfer of your personal data;
- Withdraw your consent, and
- Not be discriminated against for exercising these rights.

- To provide, operate, maintain and improve our website and our services
- To communicate with you and with our partners to provide our services
- For limited marketing and promotional purposes
